**Notes on Palmyra Luncheon**

This is for your information on parking at the library and visiting the museums after the luncheon. The library has 20 parking spaces in front including Main Street (please leave these available for those who need them) with overflow parking available in the rear. If you have difficulty walking, we would suggest you ride with someone who can drop you off in the front and that person could park in the back. There is a back door up a set of stairs for the driver to enter the library, or the driver can walk back up to the front of the library. The luncheon is on the third floor accessible by an elevator in the back of the library.

If you wish to visit the museums after our luncheon, they are a short 2 block walk down Main and Market Street. There also is a large parking lot across from the museums, perhaps a better choice. The cost for visiting all four (The Palmyra Historical Museum, William Phelps Store and Home, and Palmyra Print Shop, Erie Canal Depot) is \$5. The Alling Coverlet Museum is one block to the west on William Street and is free, with a donation box.
