Joining NYSRTA / RENY

Treasurer's Report:

As of August 1st, 2020, Joanne Bennett has reported that there is a balance of **\$524.13** in the Checking Account and **\$433.12** in the Friendly Service Account. This unit tries very hard to keep the expenses to a minimum. Some of the factors that have created a reduction of funds are: No **NEW** members--\$5.00/year does help; Lifetime Members--\$25.00 do not have to pay yearly, so no additional money comes in. The cost of postage and printing has increased. Nedra McElroy has been very kind to us when printing the 120 newsletters at the Teacher's Resource Center. This year, 120newsletters will be printed--trying to get more members to receive it via email (102). Letters and application forms are sent to all the Steuben County Superintendents and new retirees. These mailings are sent out in late spring/early summer.

It is getting to be a challenge to pay for catering at our meetings. So far we have been able to keep the cost per individual under \$20.00. Steuben does give the CWZ \$30.00/year to help send CWZ delegates to the State Convention. Since the Convention was canceled, Steuben did save \$30 this year. Steuben pays \$20.00/year for the bulk mailing fee. Even though Steuben does not have enough newsletters to qualify for bulk mailing, this Unit is obligated to contribute.

SCRTA does have raffles and door prizes at the meetings. 50% of the raffle money is given to Friendly Service. Barb Watson, Friendly Service Chairperson, does an outstanding job mailing cards to our members. Barb designs and makes the cards!!! Steuben supplies a basket full of items -\$35- to the CWZ Annual Meeting as part of their Barrie-Fleegel Active Educator Grant fundraiser.

It is our hope that we can sustain our funds to function productively in the coming years!
