Remember NYSTRA is officially now named and has been for over a year Retired Educators of New York (RENY) to better distinguish our state organization. RENY has a membership initiative which lasts until Dec. 31, 2021. Any unit member new or old who is not currently a RENY member or who is delinquent in their dues can join RENY for a three year membership for \$75, a savings of \$15. If you do not desire to join for 3 years at this time for \$75 you can always join for a year for \$30 and in either case, the check can be sent to: **RENY, 8 Airport Park Boulevard, Latham, N.Y. 12110-6414.** Many of our unit members do not belong to the state organization losing out on the benefits of belonging to the organization that serves only retired educators.
